



2016 Oceania BMX Continental Championships

Sunday 31 January 2016 - UCI CC Class - Event Guidelines

BMX New Zealand Inc. is proud to present the 2016 Oceania BMX Continental Championships. This event will be only the second time the continental championship will be held in New Zealand, once again at the Sunset Coast BMX Club track. The following guidelines will detail the event & requirement for entry.

EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - Sunset Coast BMX Club Franklin Incorporated.
Address - 80 Attewell Road, Puni, Pukekohe, Auckland Region

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Monday, 21 December 2015.
NO Late Entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES:

Challenge (20" and Cruisers) \$85.00 per Rider per Class
Championship (Junior & Elite) \$110.00

ENTRY INFORMATION:

NZ Challenge classes via **CLUB ENTRY ONLY**
Championship & all offshore riders via attached entry form
No entry will be taken on day of event.
Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.
BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
No refunds will be given after Friday 29 January 2016 for any reason. Refund prior to this will be given on receipt of medical certificate, less administration fee of \$20.

NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by club/team managers.
Riders holding a Oceania or World ranking of 1-8 may choose to enter the meeting using this ranking.
Any Championship Riders who have been provided a BMXNZ Championship plate at the 2015 North Island Titles must use this plate or order a replacement at a cost of \$25.

NATIONAL JERSEY REQUIREMENT:

Challenge riders may wear their latest national jersey to represent their country.
ALL championship class riders must ride the national jersey of his or her nation, as per UCI rule (6.1.056). New Zealand riders must ride the 2015/2016 colourway black body with white sleeves. NO other New Zealand jerseys may be worn (including HP Jerseys or 2013 Worlds versions) See your National Body to purchase the correct jersey if needed.

Challenge riders - Club Team managers only to collect: Friday 29 January 1:00 pm - 2:00 pm, Saturday 30 January 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm or Sunday 31 January 8:00 am to 8.30 am
Championship riders - individual registrations at; Friday 29 January 1:00 pm - 2:00 pm, 4:30- 5:00 pm – Saturday 30 January, 8:45-9:00 am - Sunday 31 January 8:00 am to 8.30 am

OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY :

10.30 am - Opening ceremony and speeches.

PRIZE GIVING:

Prize giving trackside 30 minutes after racing finishes

SEEDING:

Championship Riders will be seeded into motos based on their overall UCI ranking. Challenge riders based on UCI random seeding.

MOTO DRAW:

UCI transfer system used for all classes

MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

5 riders constitute a class (amalgamations as required). Class sizes will be determined after the close of entries for trophy allocation purposes.

RACING FORMAT

Championship /Challenge 20" & Cruiser Classes:

3 motos for all classes, with finals and transfer per UCI rules. In each moto, the riders will ride the same riders. At the end of the motos, the top scoring riders (normally top 4) will progress to qualifiers (semi's etc) as required using the following matrix:

8 or less riders:	3 motos Sunday, points aggregated
9 or more riders:	3 motos Sunday then;
9-16 riders:	to deadman final
17-32 riders:	to deadman semis & deadman final
33-64 riders:	to deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final
65-80 riders:	to deadman eighths, deadman quarters, deadman semis & deadman final

RACING FORMAT NOTES:

Transfer to quarter and semi finals, will be under UCI rules, Chapter 6, annex 1. In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

TIED POSITIONS:

All tied positions will be separated by Countback. No run-offs will be held.

CLASSES OFFERED AT THIS EVENT:

20" – Challenge Classes:

Male: 5 - 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, 30 plus

Female: 5 - 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 plus

Cruiser – Challenge Classes:

Male: Under 12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45 plus

Female: Under 16, 17-29, 30 plus

Championship Classes:

Male: - Elite & Juniors

Female: - Elite & Juniors

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Classes with 8 riders or less: Trophies and Race Plates to 3rd place

Classes with 9 riders: Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 7th place

Classes with 10 riders or more: Trophies to 3rd place and Race Plates to 8th place

Personalised certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS PURSE PAYMENTS:

Purse of \$5000.00 will be proportionally split between the male and female classes based on number of entries and then payout to 8th place.

Payment made in NZD

Championship riders must wear their national jersey at the prize giving ceremony.

SCRUTINEERING:

Officials will randomly check riders before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when safety gear and number plates must be worn. It is recommended that clubs & managers scrutineer all bikes prior to the event.
